AIR-100E

This is the entry level program. It is designed for the beginner or anyone new to these regulations and ideal for individual responsible for shipping (packaging goods and preparing shipping documentation). It is a comprehensive three-day program designed to take the student through the *7 steps to compliance*.

DAY 1

- Overview of the federal (TDGR/49CFR) & international regulations (ICAO, IATA)
- 7 steps to compliance
- Use of the IATA book
- Operator & state variations
- Classification of dangerous goods according to IATA (ICAO)
- Using the dangerous goods list
- General packaging requirements
- Exam

DAY 2

- Review of the previous day
- UN specification packaging (codes & construction)
- Selecting a packing instruction
- Understanding packaging instructions for cargo or passenger aircraft
- Overpacks
- Marking and labelling
- Exam

DAY 3

- Review of the previous days
- Shipper's declaration and air waybills
- Brief overview of placarding requirements
- Segregation of dangerous goods
- Accidental releases and reports
- Exceptions and special cases
 - Excepted and limited quantities
 - All packed in one (Q value)
- Exam

There is a one hour lunch break at mid-day.

Exercises are used throughout the training to confirm knowledge.
